



# Miss Davison Princess Program

## 2024 Miss Davison Pageant Princess Details

- **Princess pairing.** Each Princess is paired with a Miss Davison Candidate or a member of the 2023 Miss Davison Court depending on the number of participants. Pairings are done by the Committee and we try to accommodate pairing requests on your application as possible.
- **Participation fee of \$150 (non-refundable) is due by Friday May 24** and may be paid via our website [www.Missdavison.com](http://www.Missdavison.com) or by mailing a check payable to the Miss Davison Pageant to 9011 Davison Road, Davison, MI 48423.
- **Each Princess should wear an age-appropriate dress, “party style” or similar, for the Pageant and Parade.** It may be the same dress as used in the parade, if attended. Regular length dresses are encouraged, full-length dresses are allowed. It does not have to be really fancy. We have had a few dresses donated to the Princess Program, so if you need assistance with a dress, please contact one of the Pageant Co-Chair. Also keep in mind that they will be sitting at an elevated level on the floats so their dress should be long enough to go to their knees or you should consider them wearing shorts underneath.
- **Princess Pizza Party is Friday, May 31, 6-8 pm, John’s Pizza at 9010 Davison Road, Davison.** This event is optional. Please let us know if your Princess won’t be attending.
  - Space does not allow for parents or other family members to attend. You will drop them off and pick them up at the banquet room inside the restaurant.
  - Your princess may wear any type of short or long dress. It can be casual or a princess gown.
  - They will be eating and doing crafts so please keep that in mind regarding their dress.
  - The candidates and Miss Davison Court will be in Princess gowns.
  - Food will be pizza, breadsticks, salad and water, pop and lemonade. Please advise of any dietary restrictions.
  - They will also be practicing the crowning for on stage the night of the Pageant.
- **Festival of Flags Parade is Wednesday, June 5. Princesses must arrive at 5:15 pm. Parade starts at 6pm.** This event is optional. Please let us know if your Princess won’t be attending.
  - We will confirm lineup location but typically it is in front of the Davison Library at the corner of Fourth and Main Streets. Look for the Miss Davison Floats.
  - Princesses will be riding on the Miss Davison Candidate Float(s) and will be sitting with or near a Miss Davison teen candidate.
  - Princesses may be picked up at the end of the parade at Davison High School parking lot.
- **We currently do not have any on stage practice prior to the pageant.** If we are able to schedule one, we will provide that info at a later date.

- **Miss Davison Scholarship Pageant is Thursday, June 20, 7pm, Davison High School Auditorium, 1250 N. Oak Road (can enter off Lapeer Road).** Enter through the west entrance across from the football field.
  - **Princesses must arrive at 6:00 and report to the Band room/Backstage area with a parent.**
  - Photos will be taken with the Princess and Miss Davison 2023 backstage before the Pageant begins.
  - Princesses will then watch the first half of the Pageant from the audience and must have a parent or other authorized adult present during the entire Pageant.
  - Princesses will report backstage at designated time during the Pageant for their crowning. *(Please do not bring them backstage until asked to do so by the Emcee.)*
  - Princesses will be chaperoned backstage by the Princess Coordinators or a Pageant Assistant.
  - Princesses will be released to their parent/authorized adult following their crowning and may then return to the audience to watch the crowning of Miss Davison and Court 2024. *(Again, please do not come backstage until asked to do so by the Emcee. This will be immediately **after** the announcement of the Five Finalist so that we don't have disruption in the audience while that is taking place.)*
  - Each Princess will have a short bio read about her while she is introduced on stage during the Pageant and she will receive her crown and sash onstage. A Production Information Form will be emailed to you later for completion.
  - If time allows, Princess Parents will be introduced during the Pageant. You will be asked to stand when your name is announced.
  - Hairstyle for Pageant should be such that will allow easy placement of their Princess crown (two small combs will slide into their hair on each side of their head, near the back).
  - Tickets to the Pageant for family and friends are not included and may be purchased at the door (\$5/person, \$3/children 6-12, free/children 5 and under). The Princess is admitted free of charge.
  - Due to construction and demolition of the auditorium, there will be limited seating. We are still assessing that situation as we near the pageant. We may pre-sell tickets (and possibly assign seats) for princess parents and/or a limited number of attendees. We will advise if that is necessary.
  - Princesses are not allowed to make any appearances other than the Miss Davison Pageant and are not allowed to use the Miss Davison Princess title, crown or sash in any format other than the night of the pageant.
  - Parents or other chaperones WILL NOT be permitted backstage during any portion of the Pageant.
  - We anticipate the pageant ending at approximately 9:15pm. A reception immediately follows the Pageant in the Gym.
  - Princesses may attend the reception and take photos with their candidate, the new Miss Davison and Court as they wish.
  - The Princess Proclamation, photo with Miss Davison 2023 and flashdrive with video of the Pageant will be mailed approximately 1-2 months following the Pageant.
