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RESUME GUIDELINES and INFORMATION
DUE: Tuesday May 21 @ 4pm – Bring to Photo Session

Your resume is very important. The judging panel will use it during the personal interviews. It will also be used to obtain information for your informal conversation on stage with the Master of Ceremonies, for a biography to be read during the formal wear appearance and for press releases. It is your first impression to the Judges.

Resumes **must** be typed. No corrections will be allowed after the deadline. **You should turn in 6 copies of your resume AND 6 copies of your transcript.** Resumes should be printed in dark ink. Resumes should be one to two pages in length. Including a photo is acceptable.

Resumes **must** include the following categories:

- * PERSONAL INFORMATION: Name, age (on pageant night), grade (next year), parents, etc.
- * HOBBIES & ACTIVITIES: Scholastic clubs, activities, sports, honors, other non-school related clubs, activities, honors, general hobbies, interests, etc.
- * FUTURE PLANS: College and/or career goals, etc.
- * EMPLOYMENT: This area is optional.
- * SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT: **You will need to request this from the Guidance Office.** (9th grade through current grade) This must be an Official transcript. You can get one official transcript and then make copies of that.
- * WHY YOU WANT TO BE MISS DAVISON: Short paragraph, MORE than one sentence. This topic focuses on what you will get from being Miss Davison
- * WHAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO ACCOMPLISH AND CONTRIBUTE AS MISS DAVISON: Short paragraph, MORE than one sentence. This topic focuses on what you will give by being Miss Davison

You may include any additional information and/or categories that you feel will be important or helpful for the judges. Sample resumes will be available at 9011 Davison Road, Davison, M-Th 9-5. Sample resumes are only for viewing, **THEY MAY NOT BE COPIED OR REMOVED!**

Resumes not turned in on time will be noted as late in Pageant Responsibility. This includes turning in a resume and/or transcript late or not turning in the correct number of copies. If you will not be at the photo session, you must turn your resume in prior or it will be late.

You should keep a copy of your resume for yourself so you can review it prior to the pageant.
